Grade levels will determine which teacher teaches which scholar group.</p> <p>Teachers will provide intensive instruction in reading and math (alternating weeks) using Coach ELA/Math books; providing all scholars with a double dose in reading and math. Teachers will ensure that all scholar groups are engaged in intentional instructional activities using the following resources:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• ELA/Math Coach books</li><li>• USA Test Prep (Sci/SS)</li><li>• Moby Maxx</li><li>• Online PARCC Practice Assessments</li></ul> <p>EIP teachers will continue to pull their groups which may result in some scholars receiving a triple dose of additional support and instruction.
