Operational Reopening



Centennial Building will be closed throughout the remote learning (some in-person, small group activities, professional period development and limited office time as approved by the Facilities Manager)



No more than 50% of Centennial's staff and no more than 50 scholars will report to the building at any given time and social distancing guidelines of a minimum of 6 feet will be enforced

Face coverings are required for all scholars and staff



Temperature checks and COVID-19 symptoms screening will be conducted prior to entry for all staff and visitors

Large gatherings will be avoided

All scholars in need of a device or internet hotspot will receive one



Signage will be posted and visible reminding staff, scholars, and visitors of COVID-19 preventative measures (frequent hand washing, wear a face covering, remain 6ft. apart, etc.) per CDC guidelines
