- 1. Review By Laws

- 2. Update on Board Self-Assessment forms and Conflict of Interest form
 - Forms were sent to Jasmine Spencer for distribution
 - Board Job Description will be sent for signatures now while Assessment Form will be sent in January of 2023.
- 3. Board Training: Continue with GCSA or go another route?
 - Will continue with GSCA which cost \$1,000.00 prior to October 1st and \$1,500.00 after
 October 1st to have access to webinars and live training.
 - Reminder will be sent out to all Board Members bi-weekly that will consists of links to complete training
 - Encouraging ALL Board Members to complete ALL required training hours NO LATER THAN April 30, 2022.
 - Will confirm with Ms. Heather that all who attended Board Retreat will receive 3 hours of credit towards required training.
 - Dashboard will be presented at every meeting for everyone to see their progression.
- 4. Strategic Plan (Jessica Olowoyo, Head of School input needed)- Review goals provided at board retreat and create a schedule to ensure we are meeting goals.
 - Creating a landing page (Tablo) that will allow all Board Members to interact and review the data to see how it is aligning with strategic goals
 - Academic base line testing is complete
 - All assessments for the beginning of the year are complete
 - Attendance is a district wide issue
 - A plan is rolling out to improve attendance with it being 70-80% students attending school in K-5 and low to mid 90% students attending in grades 6-8
 - Currently working on campaigns to influence/encourage attendance with Parents and students
 - Discussed having a Resource Officer knock on doors, involving DFCS
 - Head of School applied for Redefine Atlanta grant and won \$7,500.00 that wilkl be used towards attendance campaigns/plan.

- Donation from AHA thanks to Dr. Howard Grant, is being used for the STEAM truck that is at the school every Friday.
- 97% Staff retention (8th grade teacher retired; a re-hired teacher was a no sho in August and has since been terminated as a result; non-institutional individual is included in this number)
- Community partners is increasing with a donation from Hampton Inn; new initiative with Coca-Cola "Creative Computing" is in the works for 4th & 5th graders; developing a long term partnership with Georgia Tech, "STEAM Experience' for 6th-8th students.
- Amazing turnout at "Back to School Bash" with over 300 families attending.
- First round of community/parent connections is complete with school touching 134 families.
- Volunteer opportunities on 9/24 from 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM with a collaboration between Hands on Atlanta and YMCA to paint a mural with students providing their view of what it means to be a Centennial Academy Hero/Legend to the artist that will complete; classroom improvements will also be completed.
- Dr. Howard Grant has created a Volunteer Core platfrom withn AHA that he is extending to Centennial Academy to receive volunteers when needed.
- Hands on Atlanta has seventeen (17) volunteers coming to read and donate books, tshirts to students
- Head of School wants to offer assistance to families during the holidays that may need it: Maurice Baker will make a connect with WXIA for students to participate in a Can-a-Thon on air and also get families adopted to receive holiday baskets once a list is provided to him; Rewa Berry informed about previous years that centennial Academy PTA would offer Thanksgiving baskets and Angel Tree where families receive donated gifts and choose to be an Angel to sponsor a family; Dr. Howard Grant asked for a list of families from Centennial Place Apartments that would like to participate in the AHA Turkey Drive.
