











ACADEMICS - Proficiency (Subgroups) 2023-2024 Goal: 7% point increase (30% & 26%)






ACADEMICS - Growth (Subgroups) 2023-2024 Goal: 60% Meeting Growth Target










ATTENDANCE 2023-2024 Goal: 83% scholars attend 90% enrolled days

Centennial Academy Attendance Initiative	 Engage Students and Parents by conducting weekly phone calls, emails, and conferences. We have observed a 21% increase in scholar attendance. Offer personalized early outreach, including attendance letters. We have observed a 6% percentage increase in scholar attendance. Develop a programmatic response to address barriers such as transportation issues by providing MARTA cards and Uber assistance. Address sickness concerns by communicating about sanitized classrooms before flu season begins. *Parents feel we are paying attention to them and their scholars' needs
CPA Attendance Initiative	 Notify Community Engagement Coordinator for Schoolwide Attendance Initiatives Notify families through social media and google classrooms Now offering tutoring, they will use scholar data to focus their efforts
Transitional Attendance Initiative	 Approximately 85% of scholars have relocated and are currently experiencing homelessness either due to the expiration of their allotted time or by their own choice to depart. Providing bus pass, gas cards, and hotel assistance Identifying zone schools provides challenges due to instability


