## Learning

- Options for Attendance (Families should contact to select.)
  - o In-Person
  - Hybrid
  - o Fully Online
- Buildings will be closed on Fridays for deep cleaning; learning will be eLearning

## Safety

- Masks are required for all students and staff
  - o 2 will be provided for each student and staff member
  - Will be required for transitions, group work, transitions.
  - May be removed while sitting quietly at a desk.
  - o Students who do not wear a mask will be enrolled in Fully Online Learning Plan



- Classrooms and Desks will be configured for Social Distancing, to the extent possible.
- Transportation will meet CDC guidance.
  - One student per seat. (Siblings may sit together.)
  - o Masks are required while riding all buses.
- Lunches will be "grab and go" and consumed in classrooms to avoid groups.
- Water fountains will be closed, and only used for filling individual water bottles.



## Wellness

- o Students who exhibit any of the following COVID-related symptoms should be kept at home:
  - Fever
  - Sore throat
  - Cough
  - Loss of taste or smell
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Muscle or body aches
  - Congestion or runny nose
  - Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Students and staff will all have their temperatures checked when entering school. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 will be isolated in a designated quarantine room, and a parent will be required to come pick them up. Staff will be required to leave the premises.
- Students and staff must be fever-free, without a positive COVID diagnosis, for 72 hours, before returning to school.
- No visitors will be permitted on campus; parents that wish to speak with a teacher or administrator are encouraged to do so through phone or email, or make an appointment so social distance accommodations can be arranged.
- The buildings will be cleaned every Friday, and throughout the day.
- Extra hand-washing and/or sanitizing stations will be made available for students and staff throughout the buildings.
