<p>Statement of Educational Purpose</p>	<p>Old Barracks- Your group will be sent back in time to 1777 where they will be recruited into General George Washington's Army. A soldier will prepare them for the realities of soldier's life, and even provide a live musket demonstration. They will be prepped for smallpox inoculation and learn about common 18th century medical practices. In <b>Meet the Past: Battle of Trenton</b> the group meets with a witness to the Battle of Trenton who recounts the crossing, the march, and the battle. In <b>Meet the Past: New Jersey Divided</b> they meet with a Loyalist who challenges on their readiness to join with General Washington.</p> <p>State House- Staff and volunteer tour guides escort visitors through the building, explaining its history, art and architecture. Visitors also learn about the legislative process and their representatives who work here in the state of NJ.</p>
