In **Educational Purpose** Meet the Past: Battle of Trenton the group meets with a witness to the Battle of Trenton who recounts the crossing, the march, and the battle. In Meet the Past: New Jersey **Divided** they meet with a Loyalist who challenges on their readiness to join with General Washington. State House- Staff and volunteer tour guides escort visitors through the building, explaining its history, art and architecture. Visitors also learn about the legislative process and their representatives who work here in the state of NJ.
