

Nutrition

- Contractor secured until December 31st
- Compliance Audit November 27-28, 2018
- Status letters will be distributed 11/16/18
- Will be moved to Finance beginning December 1st
- Facilities/Maintenance
 - Roofing concerns; now impacting tenants
 - Oven repaired but will need more attention over the break
 - Awaiting asset tags for inventory for Kirkwood and Gwinnett
- Information Technology
 - Laptops are now being checked for testing
 - Currently conducting bandwidth testing



- Safety and Security
 - Safety Drills being conducted in a timely manner
 - New procedures for inside dismissal will be implemented first of the year
- Data and Enrollment
 - 495 Scholars as of 11/16/18
 - Re-enrollment opened 11/5/18 and will close 12/5/18
 - 180 re-enrolled scholars
- 21st Century
 - Grant writer secured
 - Grant will be submitted by 01/31/19



- Intensive Reading support for scholars in 3rd grade
- Scholar parent meetings regarding STAR data currently taking place
- Five staff members attended EUREKA training last week
 - TOTAL OF 10 STAFF HAVE BEEN TRAINED
- Girls of Color Book Fair this week
- Jacket to Jacket Program Ended last Friday
- Microsoft partnership has provided teachers with intense training twice per month and 4th and 8th grade scholar field trips twice per month
- App Challenge Showcase is December 5th at 6:00 pm at Buckhead location for Power My Learning



- College Career Readiness Performance Indicator: multiple measure accountability system that provides a more holistic picture of school performance
 - Implemented in 2012 as an alternate to NCLB's Adequate Yearly Progress.
 - ESSA waiver provided an opportunity to implement a new accountability system that includes multiple measures
 - December 2015, Obama signed into law ESSA.
 - Georgia redesigned CCRPI to be simpler and streamlined reflection of stakeholder feedback



- Five Components
 - Content Mastery
 - Progress
 - Closing Gaps
 - Readiness
 - Graduation Rate (only for HS)
- Calculations rely heavily on data submitted annually in Student Record and Student Class
 - Other data used
 - Assessment Matching
 - Non-Participation
 - Summer scores
 - Cohort Withdrawal updates



Readiness-Literacy

• Literacy: Percent of scholars in grades 3-8 demonstrating reading comprehension at or above the midpoint of the College Ready "Stretch" Lexile Band for each grade level (Remember this for FAY scholars)

| Grade | Midpoint Lexile Score |
|------------------------|-----------------------|
| 3 rd | 670L |
| 4 th | 840L |
| 5 th | 920L |
| 6 th | 997L |
| 7 th | 1045L |
| 8 th | 1097L |



Readiness-Beyond the Core

- Beyond the Core: Percent of scholars earning a passing score in fine arts, world language, physical education/health or career exploratory
 - Classes considered
 - Theatre Arts
 - Visual Arts
 - Dance
 - Spanish
 - Health
 - Physical Education
 - A scholar must receive a passing score in one applicable course to meet the indicator criterion
 - Count of scholars in grade band coded as active at the year end with a BTC course/Count of scholars in grade band coded as active year end * 100



Readiness-Scholar Attendance

- Scholar Attendance: Percent of scholars in grades K-8 absent less than 10% of enrolled days.
 - Every scholar with an enrollment record is considered
 - There is not rounding at the scholar level
 - To determine if a scholar is absent less than 10% of enrolled days, the following calculation is applied at the scholar
 - Days Absent/Days absent + Days Present *100
 - If this absence rate is less than 10%, the scholar meets the indicator criterion
 - A scholar enrolled less than a total of 30 days is removed from the calculation unless the scholar meets the 10% criterion.



School Climate and Financial Efficiency Star Ratings

- School Climate is a rating of one to five stars
 - Scholar, teacher, and parent perceptions of a school's climate
 - Scholar discipline
 - State and substance free learning environment
 - Scholar attendance
- Financial Efficacy is a rating of one to five stars
 - Comparison of per scholar spending and overall scholar performance

These are not included in the CCRPI calculation-helps provide information of a holistic view of school performance



Elementary CCRPI

- Score is a 66.4 (was 84.6)
 - Content Mastery 58.8%
 - State was 65.7%
 - Progress 83.6%
 - State was 84.4%
 - Closing the Gap 54.2%
 - State was 85.0%
 - RED FLAGS IN ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTED IN ALL AREAS EXCEPT SCIENCE
 - Readiness 56.7%
 - State was 79.1%
 - Literacy 42.11%
 - Attendance 90.83 %
 - Beyond the Core 37.12%



- Score is a 69.3 (was 81.4)
 - Content Mastery 58.2%
 - State was 65.1%
 - Progress 93.9%
 - State was 81.0%
 - Closing the Gap 16.7%
 - State was 78.8%
 - RED FLAGS IN ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTED IN ALL AREAS EXCEPT SCIENCE
 - Readiness 82.5%
 - State was 82.4%
 - Literacy 57.41%
 - Attendance 90.21 %
 - Beyond the Core 100%
 - Fine Arts 73.10%
 - World Language 56.14%
 - Physical Education/Health 39.18%
 - Career Exploratory 26.32%
