The training shall also include two to three, hours—annually regarding sound fiscal The members of the governing board of the nonprofit organization of each charter school shall participate in initial training for boards of newly approved charter schools and annual training management and monitoring the implementation of the budget in accordance with state laws and regulations

Annually is defined as one fiscal year, July 1 through June 30.
